SAND MOVING PERMIT APPLICATION
FOR BENONA TOWNSHIP CRITICAL DUNES

It has been determined that a permit to perform sand removal is required under 1989 PA 146 and 1989 PA 147. A permit will be granted if the activity meets *all* of the following requirements:

- The sand is being moved to gain access to an existing structure or use.
- The sand which is being moved is to remain on the same property.
- No earth moving is to occur other than that absolutely necessary for gaining access to an existing structure or use.
- Sand can only be moved if the existing structure or use was occupied or actively used during the previous summer.

After answering yes to all of the criteria listed above complete the following:

- 1) A site drawing, drawn to scale, showing the following:
 - a. The area the sand is to be removed from.
 - b. The area the sand will be moved to.
 - c. How the equipment will access the site to be impacted.
 - d. Show all existing structures (including out buildings), decks, and walkways.
 - e. Show position of the first landward dune crest.
- 2) A cross section of the area where the sand will be removed and where the sand will be placed. This cross-section will show dept and contour changes.
- 3) A re-vegetation plan and stabilization plan. This can be prepared by the Oceana Soil Conservation District or a private stabilization firm.
- 4) A schedule, giving a timetable on the complete project from start to finish.
- 5) A complete explanation on why you are requesting sand removal.

Depending upon the nature of your proposal and the topography of the site, you may be required to submit additional information. You will be informed if this is necessary.

The applicant herein authorizes the Benona Township Zoning Administrator or administrator's agents to inspect the described property (be sure the area to be impacted is plainly staked) and certify that the information provided in this application is true and accurate. The applicant further agrees that if this permit application is approved the applicant will obtain all necessary earth change permits, health, building and other required state, county and township permits before conducting the activity proposed on this property.
